



## Privacy Policy

The data provided by members will be retained by The Dulwich Society (“the data holders” or “the Society”) in accordance with the provisions of the Data Protection Act 2018 and related legislation.

A minimal dataset is kept by the Society which covers each member’s title, name and address, and email address and telephone number if provided, together with the method of payment of subscriptions (no bank details are held by the Society), in order to enable the Society to meet its obligations to its members, including communication with them. Communication may be by letter, telephone, email or by other means.

The full dataset is held by the membership secretary of the Society and no personal data of any member shall be shared with anyone, other than the officers and officials of the Society and then only for the purposes of the operations of the Society. The data will not be provided to anyone not directly connected with the Society and will not be sold.

The email addresses only, are shared with an electronic mailing company for the express purpose of distributing communications to the Members of the Society relating exclusively to the operations of the Society. This company is compliant with data protection legislation. If you no longer wish to receive the eNewsletter you can easily unsubscribe on the email itself.
